Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time Blessings and Glory

The second reading from Ephesians is rather long and with only six sentences, it is not easy to follow. To put it simply, he is giving a description of the many blessings God has given us. First is Redemption, meaning that Christ saved us from punishment for our sins by forgiving them instead. Second is the plan of God for saving everyone, by making Christ ruler of the universe. We have to accept these gifts by letting go of the temptations around us and holding on to the love we have received from God. We then share that love with others, so that they know God loves them, too. As our experience of God's love grows, we begin to understand the mystery of how God lives in all people.

Paul also reminds us that we are chosen and destined to help God bring his plan, his Kingdom, to completion. When we teach children how to love and share, when we are honest with customers or suppliers, when we are not ashamed to show our faith in Jesus, when we are respectful of the poor, elderly, or disabled, we are slowly building the Kingdom of God.

Paul mentions three times in this reading about "the praise of God's glory." (Eph 1:14) When we are able to help or forgive, or just be a good example to others, we want them to know that God is in all the good we do. Instead of taking credit for the results, we give God the glory. No, you don't have to take off your glasses and put on a red cape before helping others. Just mention that God does the real work, we just try not to get in his way. Tom Schmidt,

Decimoquinto Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario Bendiciones y Gloria

La segunda lectura de Efesios es bastante larga y con sólo seis frases no es fácil de seguir. En pocas palabras, está dando una descripción de las muchas bendiciones que Dios nos ha dado. Primero está la Redención, lo que significa que Cristo nos salvó del castigo por nuestros pecados al perdonarlos. En segundo lugar está el plan de Dios para salvar a todos, al hacer a Cristo rey del universo. Tenemos que aceptar estos regalos dejando de lado las tentaciones que nos rodean y aferrándonos al amor que hemos recibido de Dios. Luego compartimos ese amor con los demás, para que ellos sepan también que Dios los ama. A medida que crece nuestra experiencia del amor de Dios, comenzamos a comprender el misterio de cómo Dios vive en todas las personas. Pablo también nos recuerda que somos elegidos y destinados a ayudar a Dios a completar su plan, su Reino. Cuando enseñamos a los niños a amar y compartir, cuando somos honestos con los clientes o proveedores, cuando no nos avergonzamos de mostrar nuestra fe en Jesús, cuando somos respetuosos con los pobres, los ancianos o los discapacitados, poco a poco estamos construyendo el Reino de Dios. Pablo menciona tres veces en esta lectura "para alabanza de su gloria" (Efesios 1,14). Cuando somos capaces de ayudar o perdonar, o simplemente ser un buen ejemplo para los demás, queremos que sepan que Dios está en todo el bien que hacemos. En lugar de atribuirnos el mérito de los resultados, le damos la gloria a Dios. No, no es necesario que te quites los lentes y te pongas una capa roja antes de ayudar a los demás. Solo mencione que Dios hace el verdadero trabajo, y nosotros simplemente intentamos no estorbarlo. Tom Schmidt,

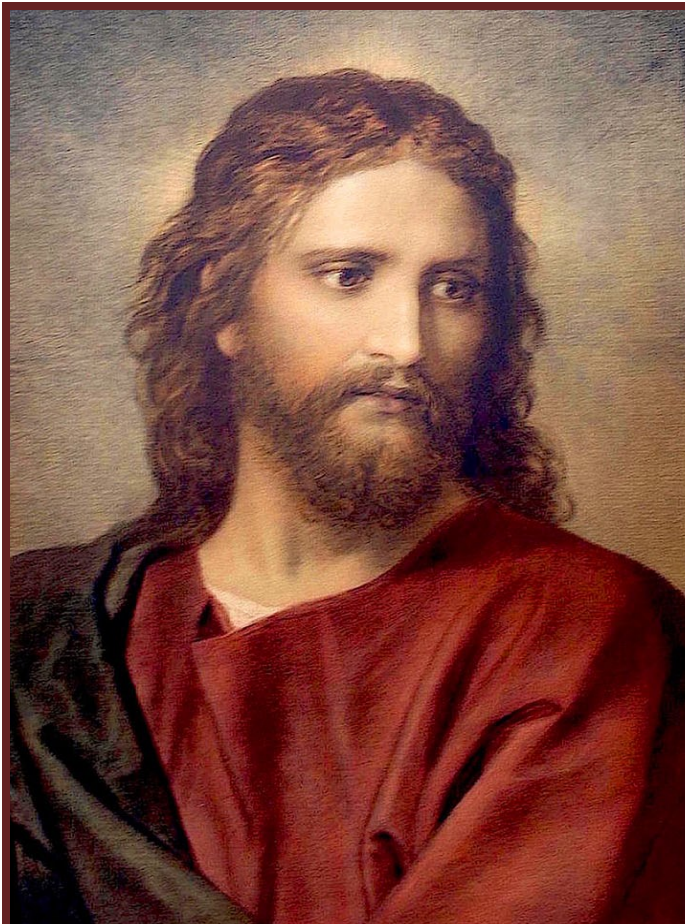

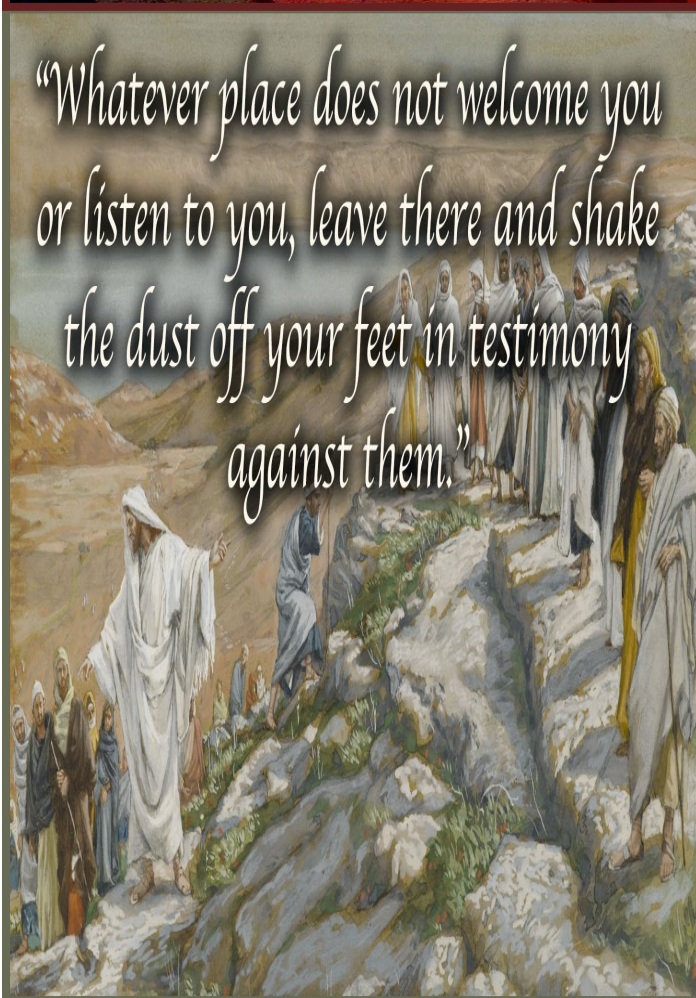
