The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ What's New?

I never noticed it before, but our reading from Mark's gospel is similar to the story in John's gospel of the wedding feast at Cana. They begin with a problem presented to Jesus: Lack of wine (John) and a place for Passover meal (Mark.) Jesus responds to both by giving orders: to the waiters (Jn) and to the apostles (Mk.) And both have miraculous changes: water into wine (Jn); bread and wine into Jesus' Body and Blood (Mk.)

Now the wedding feast showed Jesus replacing the water used for purifying dishes with wine to bring joy to the wedding. He replaced the kosher laws with a new one, the law of love, symbolized by the feast. In our gospel today, Jesus replaces ordinary food with spiritual food. He is doing something new, beyond the requirements of the Old Testament.

What does that mean for us? Jesus is showing God's love for us in a new way. The bread and wine at the last Supper were signs of Jesus' body being broken and his blood poured out for us on the cross. When he gave his life for us, he rose from the dead to give us hope. And now we have the Eucharist, in which he becomes our new food and drink.

Do we really believe that the Eucharist is Jesus, the Son of God? The way to measure that is to ask, how has Jesus changed your life? Do you love others more because you know God loves you? Do you have less fear of the future, because the Holy Spirit gives you courage? Let us look forward to being renewed in spirit whenever we receive the Body and Blood of Christ. Tom Schmidt

El Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo ¿Qué hay de nuevo?

Nunca lo había notado antes, pero nuestra lectura del evangelio de Marcos es semejante a la historia del evangelio de Juan sobre las bodas de Caná. Comienzan presentando un problema a Jesús: Falta de vino (Juan) y falta de un lugar para la cena de Pascua (Marcos). Jesús responde a ambos dando órdenes: a los camareeros (Juan) y a los apóstoles (Marcos) y ambos tienen cambios milagrosos: agua en vino (Juan); pan y vino en el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Jesús (Marcos)

Ahora, en la fiesta de bodas, Jesús reemplaza el agua usada para purificar los platos con vino para traer alegría a la boda. Reemplaza las leyes judías por una nueva, la ley del amor, simbolizada por la fiesta. En el evangelio de hoy, Jesús reemplaza la comida ordinaria por la comida espiritual. Está haciendo algo nuevo, más allá de los requisitos del Antiguo Testamento.

¿Qué significa eso para nosotros? Jesús está mostrando el amor de Dios por nosotros de una manera nueva. El pan y el vino en la última Cena fueron signos del cuerpo de Jesús siendo partido y su sangre derramada por nosotros en la cruz. Cuando dio su vida por nosotros, resucitó de entre los muertos para darnos esperanza. Y ahora tenemos la Eucaristía, en la que Él se convierte en nuestro nuevo alimento y bebida.

¿Creemos realmente que la Eucaristía es Jesús, el Hijo de Dios? La forma de medir eso es preguntar cómo Jesús ha cambiado tu vida? ¿Amas más a los demás porque sabes que Dios te ama? ¿Tienes menos miedo al futuro porque el Espíritu Santo te da valor? Miramos con anticipación ser renovados en espíritu cada vez que recibamos el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo. Tom Schmidt

Communal First Saturday Devotion

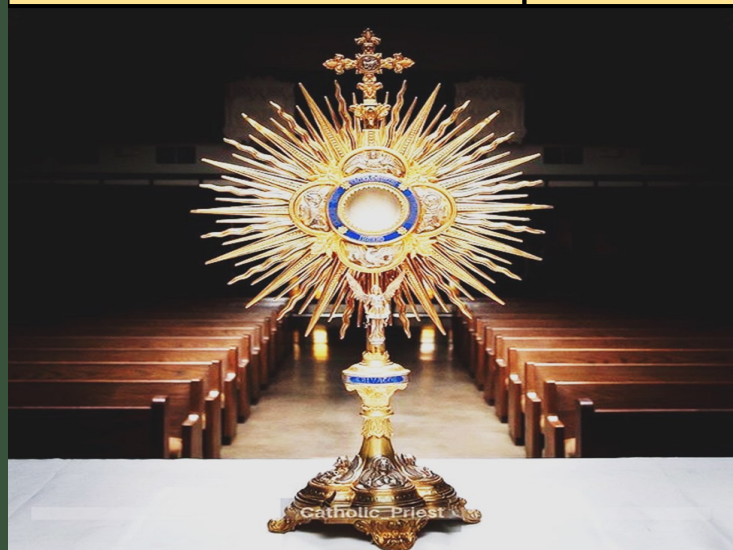
Every First Saturday,
